Our unique program specializes in providing a high quality, small family home childcare experience to older children and teens who have developmental disabilities and are still in school. We also care for siblings under private pay arrangements. Transportation to the childcare program must be provided by parents, primary caregivers, or school buses.

Our home is accessible for children who use wheelchairs or walkers. To maintain the safety of all children in care, children who exhibit aggressive or loud behaviors may not be suitable for our program. Once the daycare reaches a capacity of five children, those requiring toileting assistance may be considered for admission. Each child will be assessed individually and all attempts made to accommodate their needs.

Snacks will be provided each afternoon, dependent upon special dietary restrictions. Occasional community outings, especially in the summer, will be organized for all children who wish to attend. Volunteers and college interns may be utilized in the program to supplement staffing. Our program trains volunteers and interns for future careers in our field.
